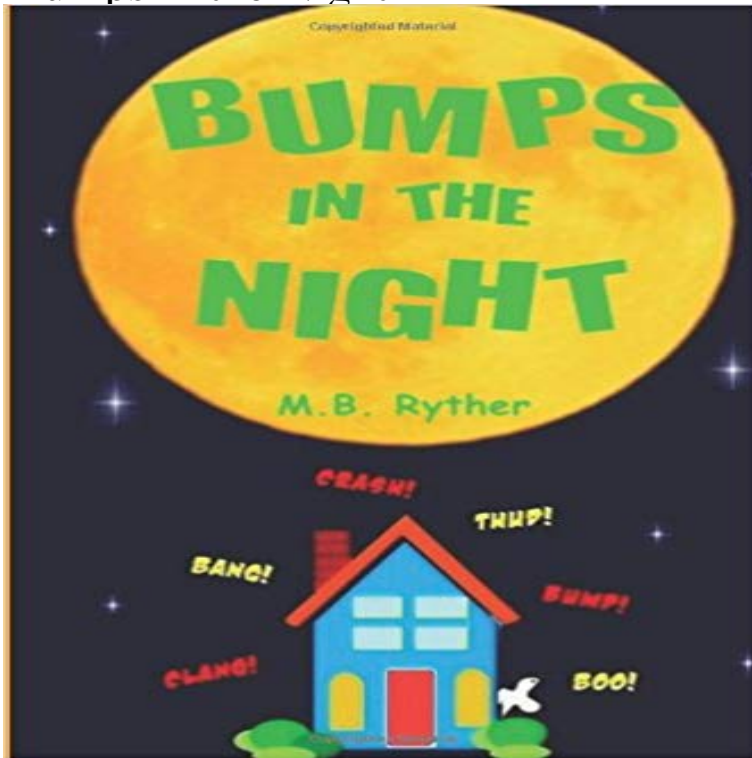


## Bumps in the Night
